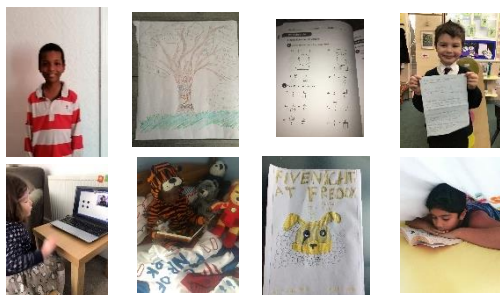
Lateral Flow Testing
