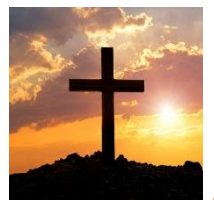

Year 2 children enjoyed learning about the Passover meal that was celebrated at the last supper.



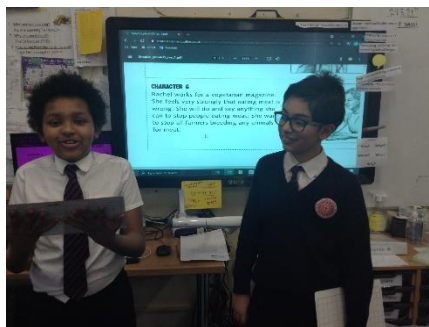
Year 3 loved re-enacting the stations of the cross for the rest of the school.



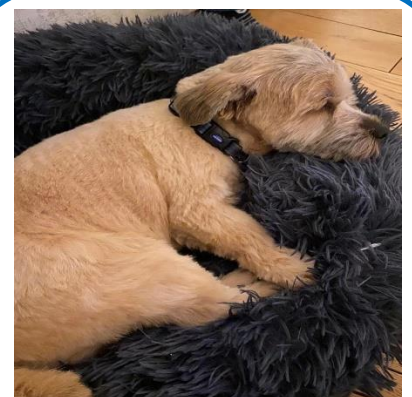
Year 4 also enjoyed re-enacting the stations of the cross for the rest of the school.
