## Holy Communion

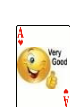

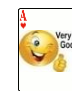

Nursery loved learning all about Islam. They have looked at prayer mats and designed their own.



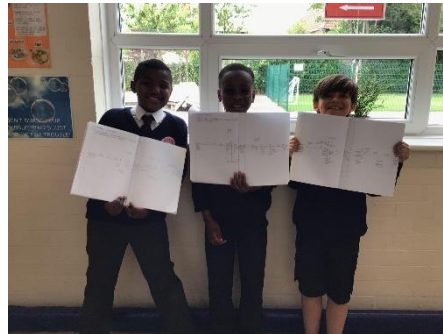
Reception have loved the sunshine and made a class den to create shade in the gift garden.
