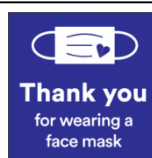
## St. Peter and St. Paul

## Thank you



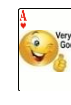

Year 1 loved the amazing experiments they got to do in the science workshops.



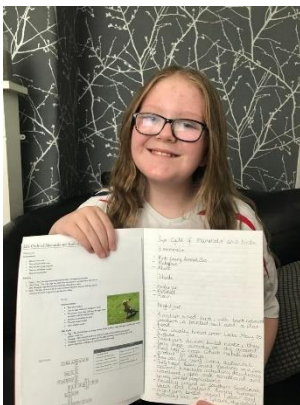
Year 2 loved exploring all things science this week, including gravity.
