Coronavirus update

Dear Parent/Guardian

You will be aware that the government has now increased their response to the outbreak of Coronavirus and as part of their delay plan, now ask that anyone with a fever or persistent cough self isolates for 7 days, irrespective of whether you have travelled or been in contact with someone known to have the virus.

If your child presents with any form of temperature above 37.8 degrees, develops or have a cough, we ask that you keep them home for 7 days.

If you or any family member presents with such symptoms, we ask that you inform us of your self-isolation and do not come to school any point during the self-isolation period.

In line with population distancing measures, we are postponing **all assemblies** until further notice, reducing the number of visitors as well as the following:

Year 5 parent's drop in session - Wednesday 18th March

Ghyll Head Parents' meeting - Thursday 19th March

Parents' Evening - Thursday 2nd April.

From today, these clubs will not happen:

Also, sports competitions against other schools and tournaments have been postponed until after Easter.
