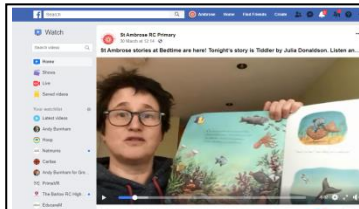


Times Tables Rock Stars

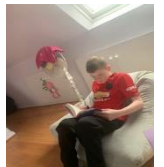
