Recognising Coronavirus (COVID-19) Symptoms

Symptoms	Covid-19 Symptoms range from mild to severe	Flu Rapid onset of symptoms	Cold Gradual onset of symptoms
Fever (37.8C or above)	Common	Common	Rare
Fatigue	Sometimes	Common	Sometimes
Cough	Common (usually dry)	Common (usually dry)	Mild

Nursery have enjoyed making their own zoo after reading our new story 'Monkey and me.'



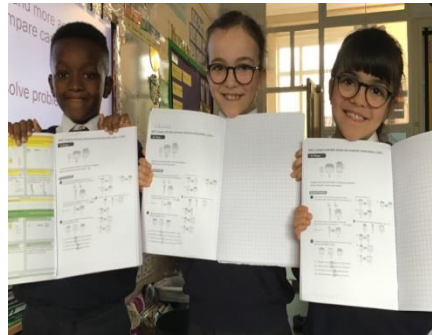
Reception have been solving a crime this week as they all became police officers.



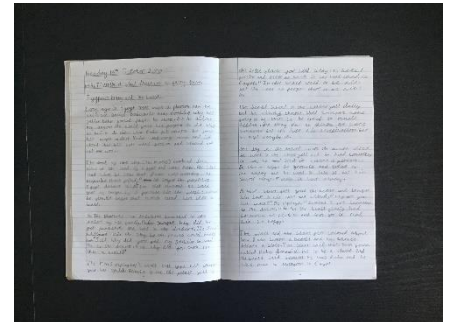
Yellow Brick Road Toy Workshop visited Year 1. The children created a timeline of old and new toys whilst having fun learning.



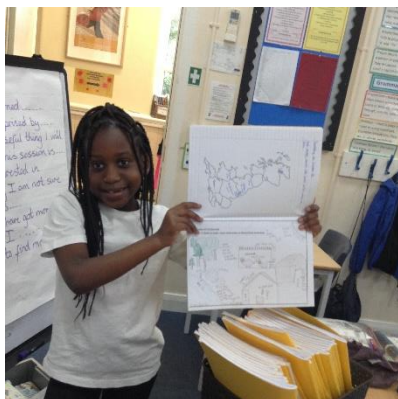
Year 2 went on a science investigation to Chorlton Water Park to explore and identify and classify the different trees there
