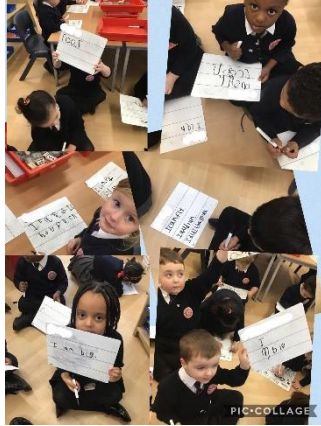


# Loving Our Learning

Year One have enjoyed learning how to peel and chop different types of fruit.



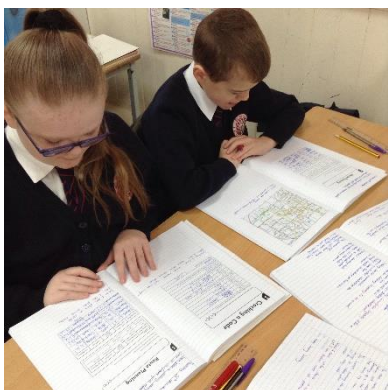
Year 2 have been building paper bridges as part of their science learning this week.
